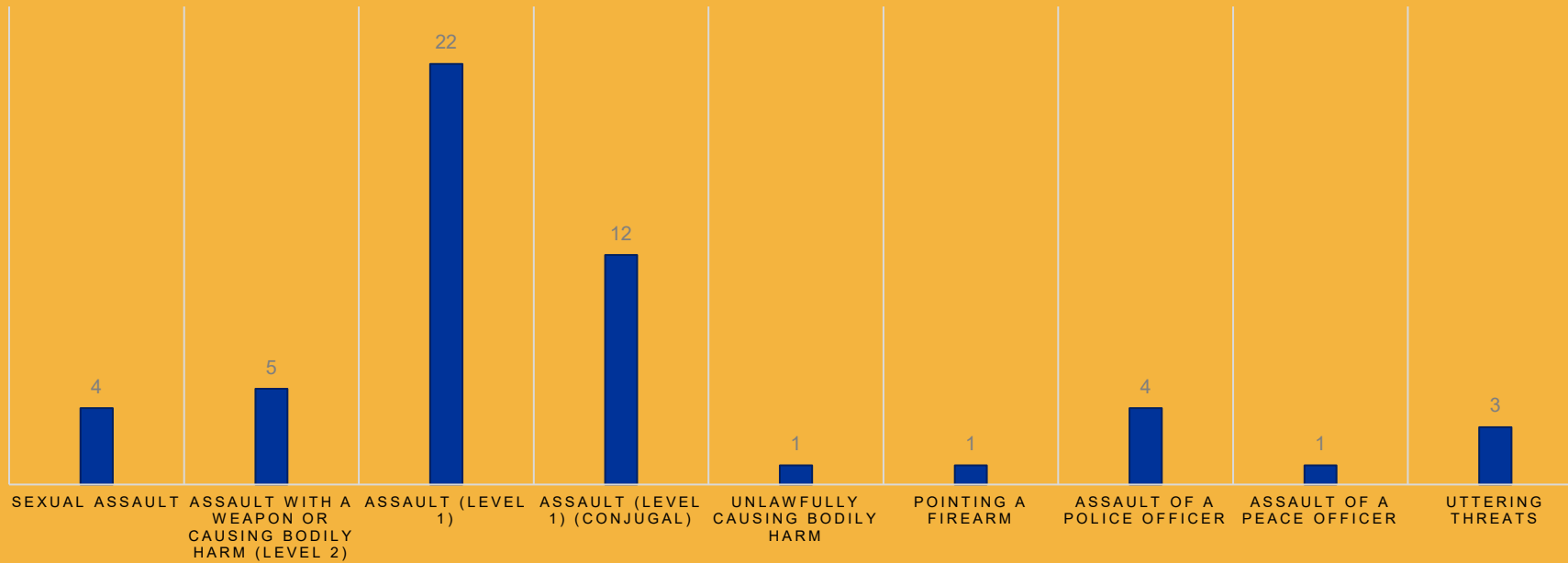

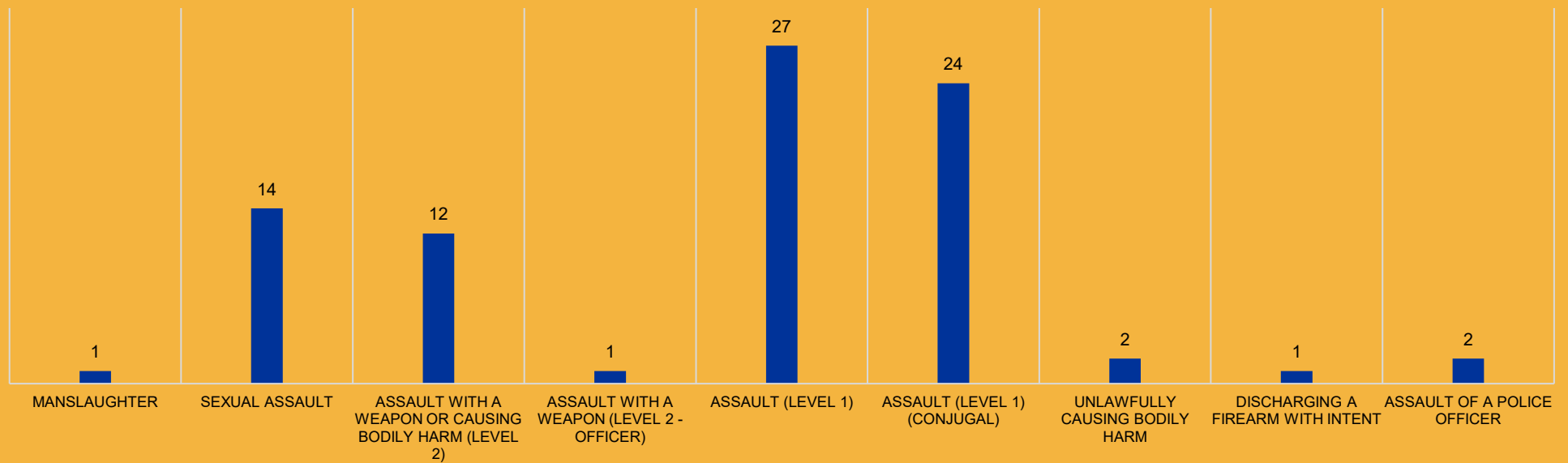

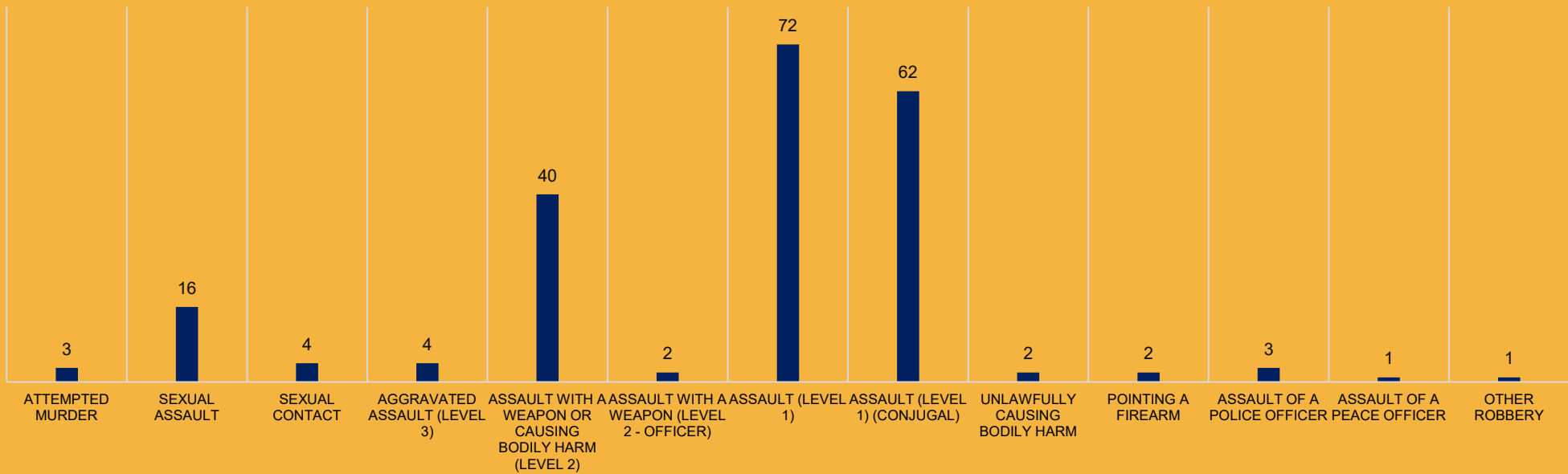

Most common violent crime across all departments

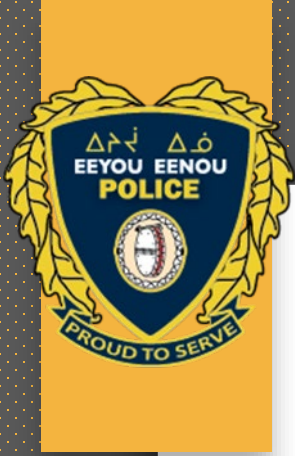

Key Suicide & Mental Health Findings (All Departments)

- Mental-health related calls are extremely frequent, often exceeding traditional criminal calls.
- Mistissini, Waswanipi, Waskaganish, and Chisasibi account for the majority of suicide-related workload.
- Suicidal remarks far outnumber actual attempts, indicating:
 - High prevention demand
 - Significant time spent on assessment, monitoring, and follow-ups

Youth suicidal remarks are present **in every major community.**
